Dear Sir,

This has reference to the meeting of the Andhra University Standing Committee on autonomous colleges held on 11-4-1987 recommending grant of autonomy to the following colleges:

1. DNR College, Bhimavaram
2. Sir C.B.R. College, Eluru
3. Ch.S.D. St. Theresa's College for Women, Eluru
4. S.R.V.S.S.J.R. Maharanas College, Peddapuram
5. S.D.S. College of Arts & Applied Science, Shreeram Nagar
6. H.R. College for Men, Vizianagaram
7. St. Joseph's College for Women, Waltair, R.S.

These recommendations have been concurred to by the Chairman, Commissionerate of Higher Education, Andhra Pradesh State Government vide letter dated 9-5-1987.

I am now pleased to convey concurrence of the UGC to the grant of autonomous status to the aforesaid colleges by the Andhra University. This is subject to the following:-

- i. The colleges shall constitute organizational structure on the lines suggested in the UGC Revised Guidelines (1986) on the scheme of autonomous colleges, which may be agreed to by the university;
- ii. the autonomous status may be granted by the university for a period of five years in the first instance and review shall be undertaken by the university after three years as to the performances/functioning of the colleges with the help of the Committee as indicated in the UGC guidelines; and
- iii. the colleges shall start functioning as 'autonomous' from the commencement of the academic session 1987-88.

3. Necessary orders granting autonomous status to the colleges be issued by the University under intimation to

to the Commission. The university may also ensure that the colleges constitute the required committees as per the UGC guidelines.


6. The UGC assistance to the colleges will be available on receipt of information from the university that the colleges have adopted organizational structure and started functioning as autonomous colleges, in accordance with the guidelines.
